LOGIBEC ANNOUNCES NORMAL COURSE ISSUER BID

Montréal, September 16, 2004. Logibec Groupe Informatique Ltd. (TSX: LGI) announces that the Toronto Stock Exchange has approved its normal course issuer bid. Under the normal course issuer bid, Logibec will be entitled to repurchase for cancellation up to a maximum of 333,706 Common Shares over the twelve-month period starting September 20, 2004 and ending September 19, 2005, representing 5% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares. The purchases by Logibec will be conducted through the facilities of the Toronto Stock Exchange. As at September 15, 2004, there were 6,674,124 Common Shares issued and outstanding. The normal course issuer bid has been instituted because Logibec believes that the repurchase of shares at certain market prices will be beneficial to Logibec and to its shareholders.

To the knowledge of the Corporation, no director, officer or insider of Logibec intends to sell their Common Shares.
