LOGIBEC CLOSES C\$40 MILLION CREDIT FACILITIES

Montréal, December 10, 2007 – Logibec Groupe Informatique Ltd. (the “Company” or “Logibec”) today announced that it closed two secured credit facilities aggregating C\$40 million provided equally by National Bank of Canada and The Bank of Nova Scotia. These facilities will be used to reimburse the temporary credit facilities put in place on November 19, 2007 to finance the acquisition of the assets of Achieve Healthcare Technologies L.P. They will also serve to finance the Company’s growth strategy in the United States.

The credit facilities are comprised of revolving reducing term loans that mature in September 2012 and that are repayable in quarterly instalments beginning June 2008.
