LOGIBEC ANNOUNCES THE RENEWAL OF ITS NORMAL COURSE ISSUER BID

Montréal, February 11, 2009 – Logibec Groupe Informatique Ltd. (TSX: LGI) announces the renewal of its normal course issuer bid. Subject to approval by Toronto Stock Exchange, Logibec will then be entitled to repurchase for cancellation up to a maximum of 472,189 common shares over the twelve-month period starting February 13, 2009 and ending February 12, 2010, representing 5% of the issued and outstanding common shares. The purchases by Logibec will be conducted through the facilities of Toronto Stock Exchange. The purchase price for shares repurchased under the normal course issuer bid shall be the market price at the time of purchase. As at February 11, 2009, there were 9,443,783 common shares issued and outstanding. Logibec considers that the repurchase of shares at certain market prices will be beneficial to Logibec and its shareholders.

During the most recently completed six calendar months, the average daily trading volume for the common shares of Logibec was 4,712 common shares. Consequently, under the rules and policies of Toronto Stock Exchange, Logibec has the right to repurchase during the same trading day a maximum of 1,178 common shares. Moreover, Logibec may make once per calendar week and in addition to the 1,178 common shares daily repurchase limit, one block (as such term is defined in the Toronto Stock Exchange Company Manual) purchase of common shares not directly or indirectly owned by insiders of Logibec in accordance with the rules and policies of Toronto Stock Exchange.

On November 3, 2008, in its Staff Notice 2008-0005, Toronto Stock Exchange granted a temporary relief, in effect until March 31, 2009, to listed issuers making purchases under a normal course issuer bid. Under the temporary relief, listed issuers are authorized to purchase daily on Toronto Stock Exchange up to a maximum of 50% of the average daily trading volume instead of the maximum of 25% prescribed by the rules of Toronto Stock Exchange. For Logibec, this means a possibility of daily purchases of up to 2,356 common shares under its normal course issuer bid, until March 31, 2009.

During its normal course issuer bid which will expire on February 12, 2009, Logibec will have repurchased an aggregate of 497,041 common shares at an average price of \$17.69.
